- suitcase (students are allowed only **ONE** piece of luggage)
- any and all music you have throughout the first week
- spirit wear for spirit days
 - Sunday- tropical
 - o Monday- cross-dress
 - o Tuesday- class color (9th/rookie- white, 10th- red, 11th- purple, 12th- blue)
 - o Wednesday- section spirit
- swimsuit and towel
- toiletries (toothbrush, soap, deodorant, feminine hygiene products, etc.)
- sleeping bag (or blanket and sheets) and pillow
- insect repellent
- fan
- any and all food must be in a RESEALABLE bag or container

For this reason, please be sure that medications are NOT packed with your luggage so that you can check them in at the school before boarding the buses.
