Dear Marching Band Students and Parents,

Here is all the information you need to know for the Pep Rally and Homecoming Parade and Game tomorrow.

<u>Pep Rally!</u> As always, the marching band will be featured at the Pep Rally on Friday. You need to be dressed in casual uniform (long pants/jeans are permitted). You may choose to wear casual uniform all day, or change into casual uniform during your lunch. We will play stand tunes and Sportscenter on the field. Pit and guard members will participate in the cheers and dancing!

Homecoming Parade and Game! We are the leaders of our annual Homecoming parade as we represent the best of Perry Hall! Report time is 3:45pm in the Band Room. As soon as you arrive, change into full uniform. *You will need to bring black socks and white gloves to school that day!* You will then begin walking up to the Perry Hall Shopping Center parking lot. Everyone should be fully dressed and moving to the Perry Hall Shopping Center parking lot by 4:15pm. You should be in parade block formation by 4:30pm. For the parade we will play the cadence and fight song.

Once we arrive back at school, you will have approximately 30-45 minutes to eat dinner before setting up in warm-ups for the football game. Plan on bringing a bag lunch, have your parents bring you dinner, or eat at the tailgate provided by StuCo.

<u>Senior attire</u>: As is tradition, Seniors will be allowed to dress in spirit gear for the parade and game. This means you do not have to be in full uniform. You may choose to paint your face, change your hair color, and whatnot. But you must wear blue jeans and generally blend in with our blue uniform color.
