Are you getting ready for our DOUBLE PARADE weekend! On Saturday, 12/1 we will return to the Avenue at White Marsh to escort Santa down the parade route. Then on Sunday, 12/2 we will make our debut at the Mayor's Christmas Parade in Hampden in front of 25,000 people!

## 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Holiday Parade on The Avenue

On Saturday, 12/1 students are required to report to the line-up location noted below NO LATER than 9:30am. THERE WILL BE NO TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED.

There are two ways to make this happen:

1. The high school will be open at 8am if you would like to get changed, get your instrument, and then report to the line-up location.
2. Take your instrument and uniform home during the week and report directly to the Line-up location.

The parade begins at 10 am and the parade route will start by Pier1 and conclude by Staples. We will use Honeygo Blvd. to return to the staging area. There will be spectator seating available along the entire route. The parade should conclude by 12pm. At the conclusion of the parade you will need to do one of two things:

1. Get a ride to go back to PHHS to put away your uniform and instrument.
2. Return home and bring your uniform and instrument back for the parade the next day.

The parade begins at 1pm and the parade route will start by Baltimore Polytechnic Institute (Poly), South on Falls Road, East on 36<sup>th</sup> Street, North on Chestnut Avenue, and end at 37<sup>th</sup> Street. There will be spectator seating available along the entire route.
