



If you are reading this packet then you have the opportunity to be a part of one of the most recognizable and award-winning organizations at Perry Hall High School: the Marching Band! All students registered for band are eligible to become members of the Perry Hall High School Marching Band. Students who are interested in being in the Percussion Section or the Color Guard (flags, rifles, and dance) may need to audition to be in the marching band due to the limited positions in those sections. These sections will also have rehearsals and practices during the summer months (June and July). They will be scheduled at the discretion of their instructional staff with support from and in conjunction with the directors, Mr. Engel and Mr. Kupyak.

Incoming ninth grade students are HIGHLY encouraged to take part in the marching band for their first year in the band program. This is one of the only clubs/activities you can be a part of for all four years of high school; this looks GREAT on college applications! Attached to the back of this packet is a schedule of summer practices and events that all marching band members must attend according to the grid. Please review it, detach it, and keep it for reference; a regularly updated calendar is maintained on our wiki site indicated at the top of this page. All summer rehearsals are mandatory, but if you have a conflict please contact a director as soon as possible to see if alternate plans can be arranged.



The marching band fees for the 2019 season are \$325. You may pay the full cost of the fees at the registration meeting on Thursday, June 6 or you may pay in two installments as indicated below. All fees are nonrefundable.


