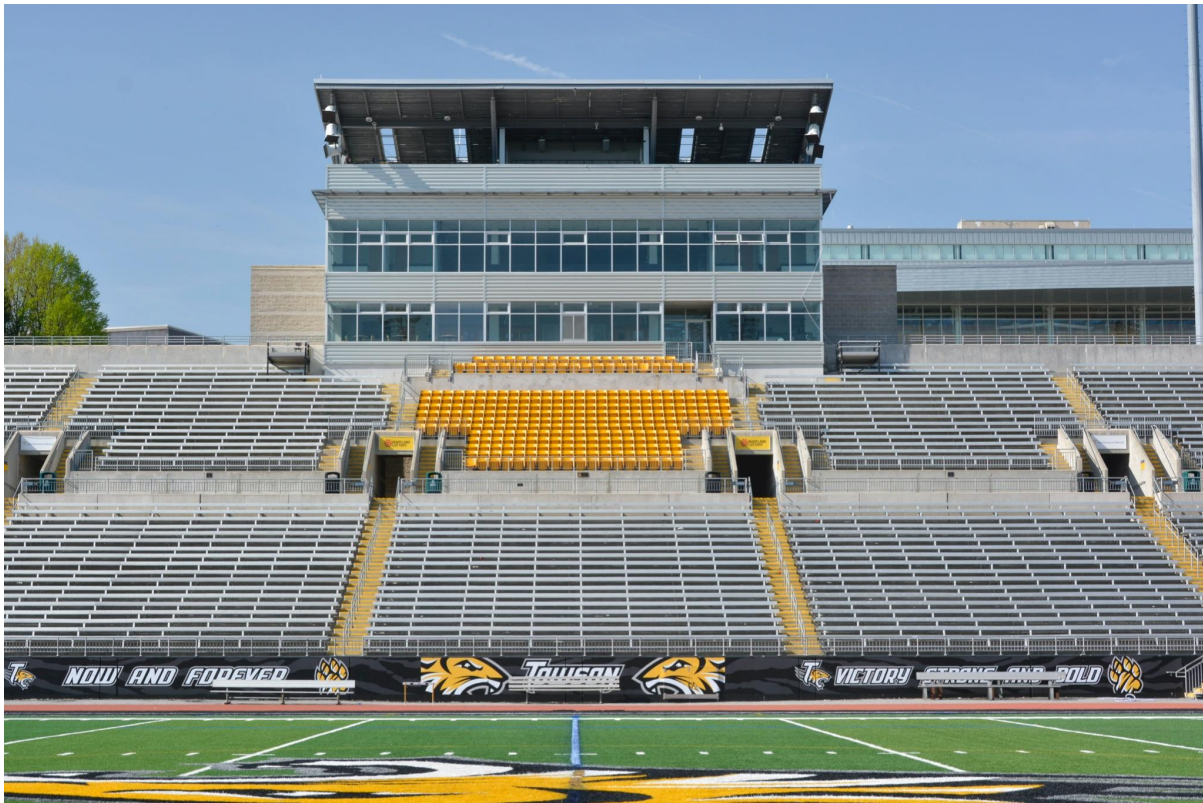

Important Event Information:

Arrival: Busses and equipment vehicles should approach Lots 4 and 5 on Auburn Drive From Osler Road.

Parking: Upon arrival, busses will be directed to park on Lot 5 and equipment vehicles will be directed to park on Lot 4. Spectator parking will be in Lot 8 with overflow parking in the Union Garage. There is no charge for parking anywhere on campus that day.

As indicated in the show schedule, equipment vehicles are instructed to depart 90 minutes after the band's performance time. We highly encourage vehicles to leave campus at that designated time. However, a temporary holding area will be available if needed, please see maps below.

Warm-Up: Warm-up will be located behind the busses on Lot 5. An event host will greet each ensemble and escort them to the warm-up and competition areas. 3A, OS, and OL bands will also have the option to warm-up on the Lower Athletic Field if that is preferred. In either location, please be respectful of the shared space and try to keep your band as consolidated as possible. Bands using the Lower Athletic Field should consider the hill to and from that location. We do not recommend bringing your front ensemble to that location.

Restrooms: During warm-up, there are bathrooms available between Lot 4 and the stadium. For 3A, OS, and OL bands using the Lower Athletic Field for warm-up, there are only 2 portable bathrooms in that area so please plan accordingly. Once inside the stadium, there are bathrooms located throughout the concourse area on the press box side.

Prop Staging: For bands who would like to pre-set props and/or electronic equipment in the stadium, a space will be available in the Side



1 end zone near the Auburn Drive track level entrance. Do not pre-set props more than 1 hour before your performance time.

Stadium Field Surface/Entrance: The field is turf with high school and college markings. Ensembles and all equipment will enter and exit the stadium from the Auburn Drive track level entrance (back, side 1). Any motorized vehicles driven into the stadium must have an oil bib underneath.

Retreat: Drum majors will report to the stadium field for retreat.

Tickets: Each band will receive 20 complimentary tickets before the show. Otherwise, admission is \$15 for all spectators and tickets can be purchased at the stadium box office. Children under 3 years are admitted free of charge.

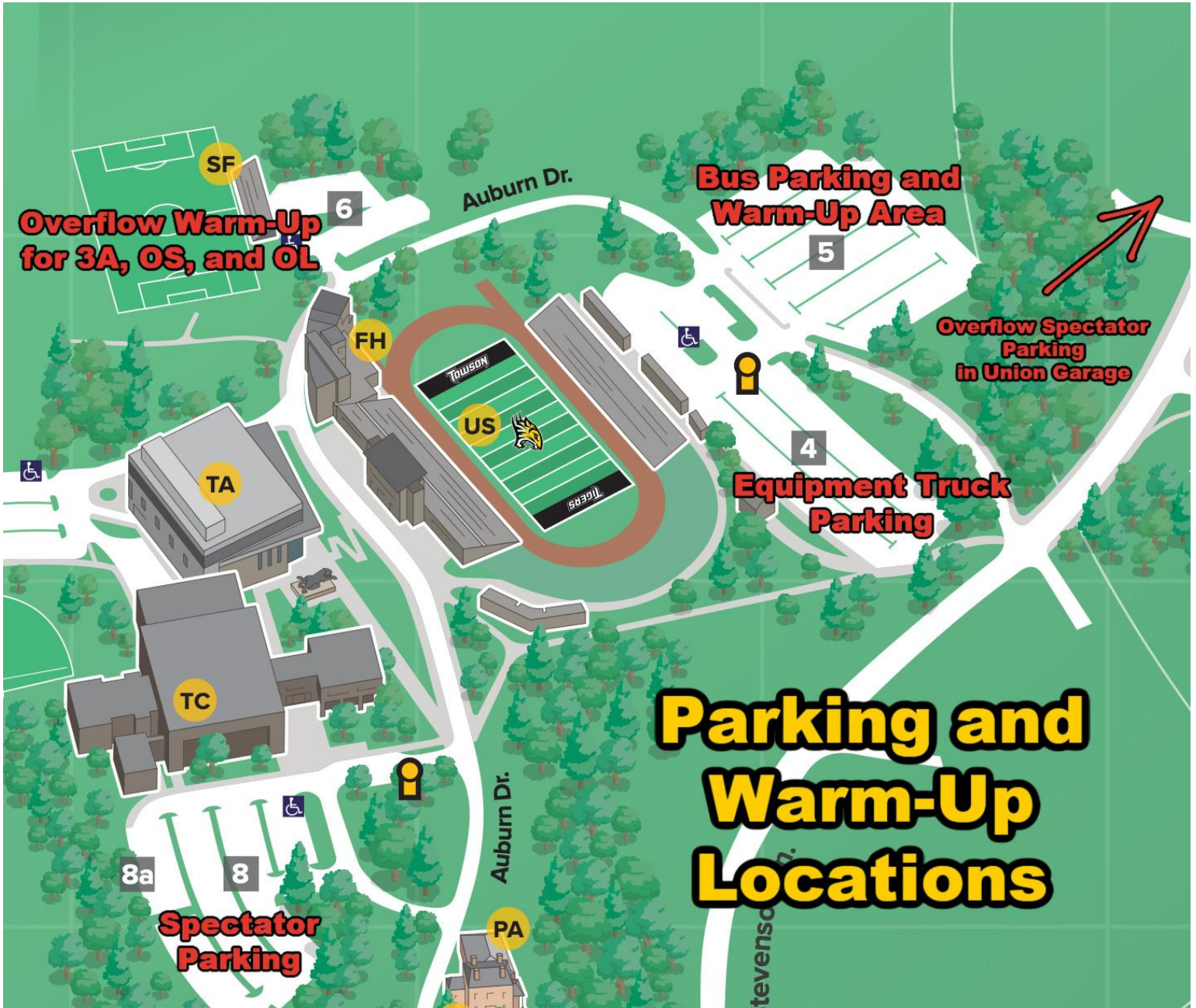
Member Re-Entry: Spectators and members will enter the stadium through the main gate. Spectators will be given ticket stubs and hand stamps. Each band will be given 5 additional wristbands for chaperones/volunteers.

Concessions: Concessions will be available throughout the day in the concourse area of the stadium underneath the press box.

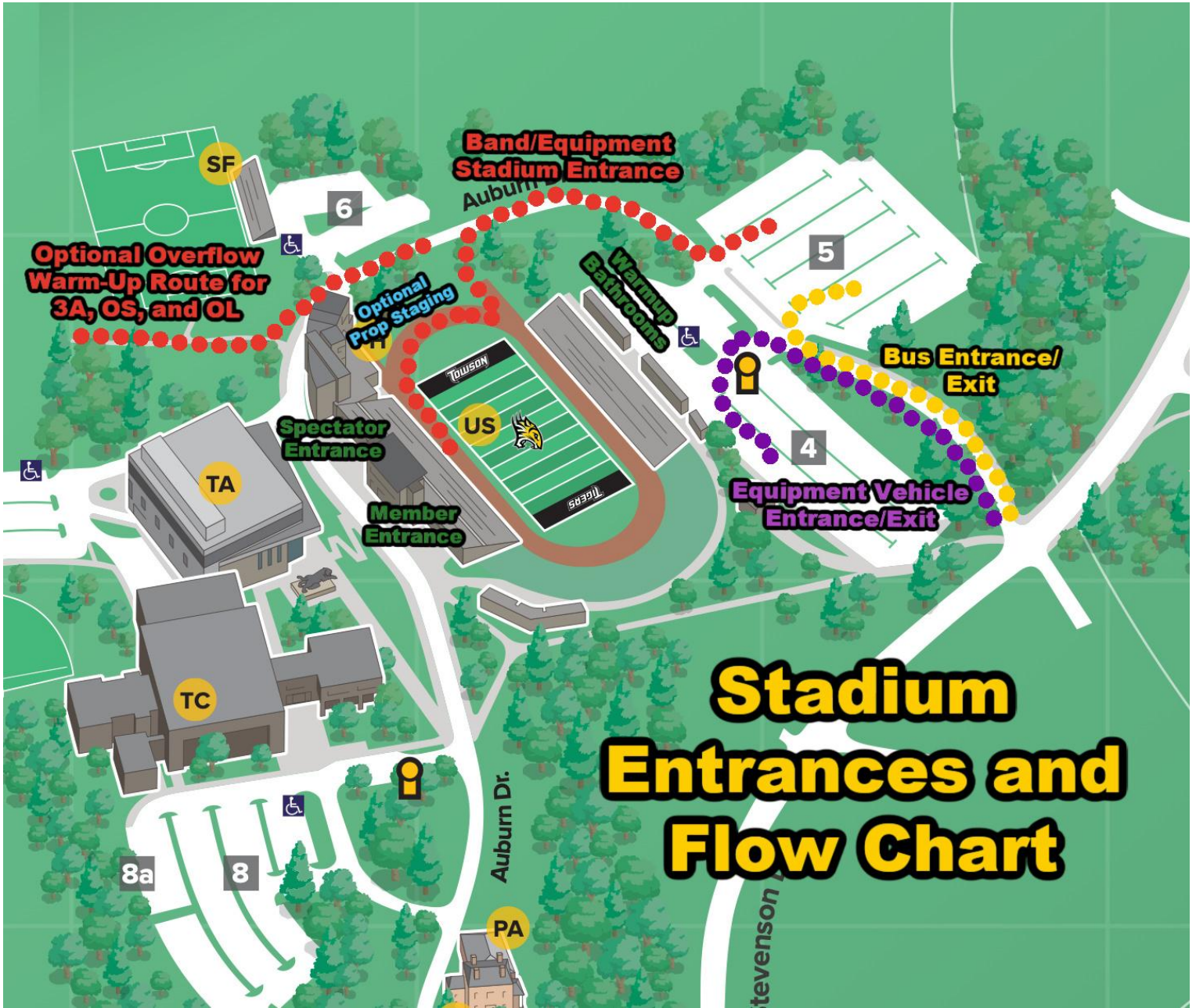
Handicap Accessibility: Please see Johnny Unitas Stadium Policy below.

Site Overview Maps:

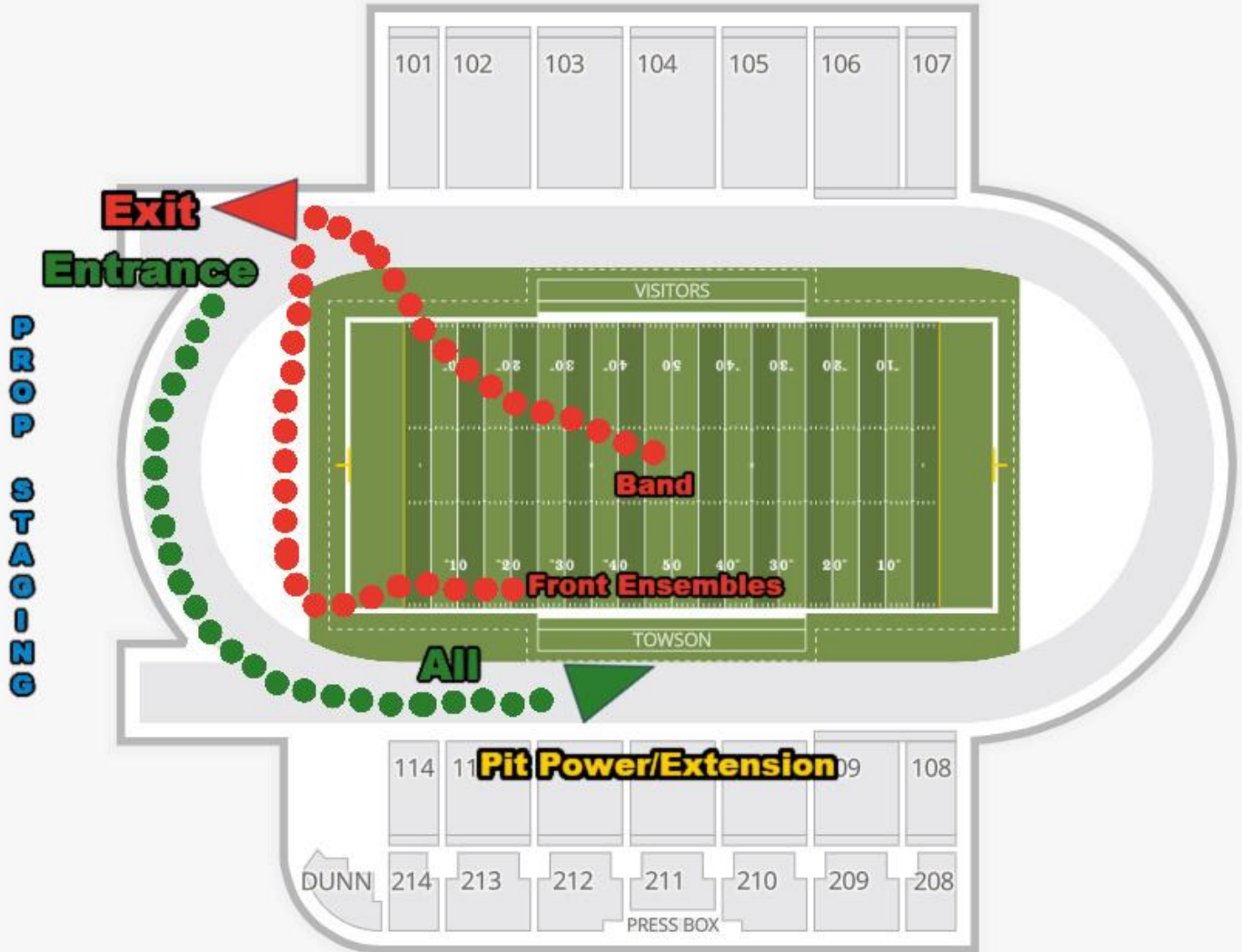

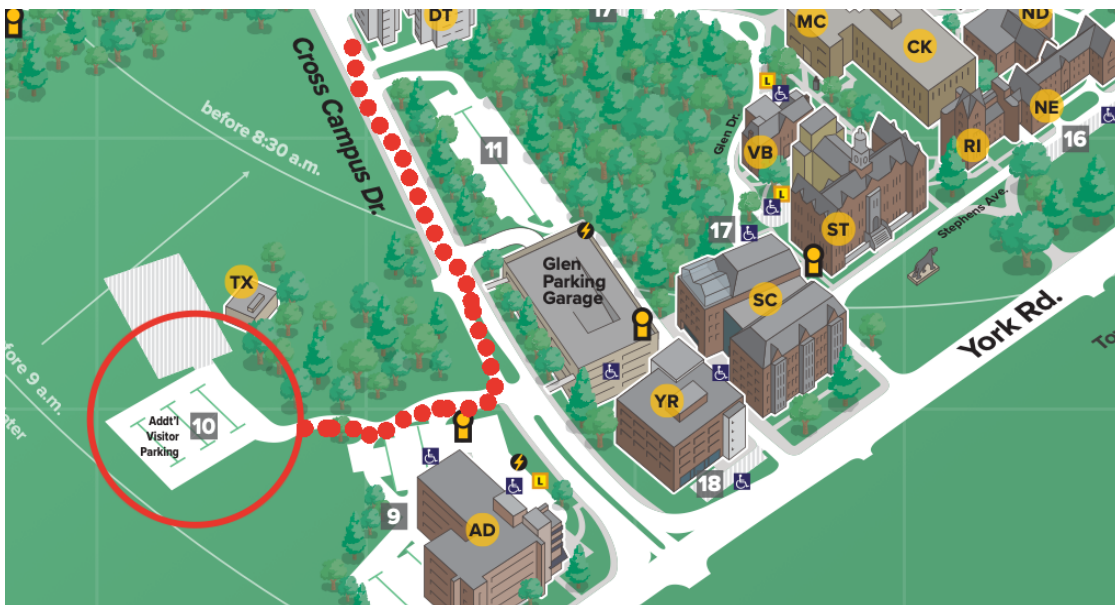
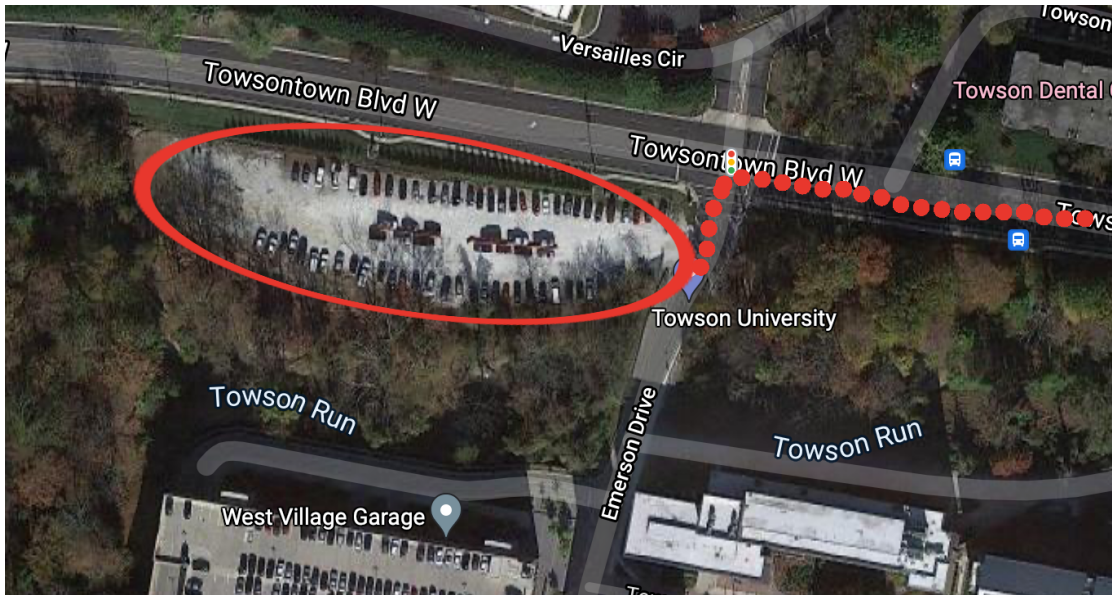
Site Overview Maps:

Johnny Unitas Stadium Policies:

The following items are not permitted in Johnny Unitas® Stadium:

- **Alcohol**
- **Animals** (except service animals)
- **Audio Recording Equipment**
- **Backpacks, Bags larger than 11" x 14" x 4", Bota Bags or wine skins, flasks**
- **Beverages**
- **Bicycles**
- **Cameras (still) with lens greater than 1 ft.** (along with Monopods, Dual Pods and Tripods)
- **Containers** (common examples include, but are not limited to: hard sided coolers, soft pack coolers, ice chests, picnic baskets, cans, bottles, flasks, thermoses)
- **Computers/Laptops/I-Pads/Tables**
- **Confetti, streamers, glitter, balloons**
- **Food** (persons with small children or medical infirmities may be exempt)
- **Illegal Drugs**
- **Laser Pointers**
- **Markers (permanent) and/or paint/Dry Erase Boards**
- **Noisemaking devices** (common examples include, but are not limited to: whistles, air horns, bull horns, blow horns, musical instruments, kazoos, bugles, cow bells, thunder sticks, sirens, and boom boxes) – Excluding all marketing giveaways
- **Sticks or Poles**
- **Sports Equipment** (common examples include, but are not limited to: balls, beach balls, footballs, baseballs, lacrosse balls, Segway's or other motorized scooters, skateboards, and roller blades)
- **Televisions**
- **Open Umbrellas**
- **Video Recording Equipment**
- **Weapons** (common examples include, but are not limited to: aerosol cans, mace, pepper spray, firearms, including CCW permit holders, fireworks, pocket knives, knives, spiked bracelets, brass knuckles, martial arts weapons, stun guns, super soakers and chains)

Smoking and Tobacco Policy

Towson University is a smoke-free campus. Smoking anywhere on campus including parking lots and the university grounds is prohibited.

Accessible Seating/ Hearing Assistance

Please call the University Ticket Office at (410) 704-2244 at least **2** business days in advance during business hours so the university may accommodate you and your specific needs. Wheelchair seating is located above sections 102, 106, 110 of SECU Arena.



Animals

Service animals are welcome in Johnny Unitas® Stadium.

Artificial Noisemakers

Artificial noise makers (air horns, cowbells, etc.) are not permitted into Johnny Unitas® Stadium. Be considerate and allow your neighbor to enjoy the game.

ATM

There is an ATM on the Press Box side concourse across from the University Store.

Bags and Backpacks

For the safety and enjoyment of all fans attending the game, large bags 11" x 14" x 4" are NOT permitted into Johnny Unitas® Stadium. All bags and purses are subject to inspection. Individuals that refuse to have a bag inspected will not be allowed to enter the stadium.

Banners

Signs, banners, pictures, etc., that are offensive to individuals and teams, which are not in good taste, that block the view of spectators or create a safety hazard will not be allowed. The hanging or displaying of signs on stadium walls, bleacher areas, ramps, or on an area of proximity to the stadium is prohibited as a safety precaution, and to avoid defacing of property with tape, glue, nails, or other materials.

Credit Card Policy

Only Visa, MasterCard and Discover may be used to purchase tickets at the Stadium Box Office or at stadium concession stands.

Drinking Fountains are available on each concourse.

Emergency Procedures

In case of emergency, the public address announcer will notify fans of developing situations, including inclement weather, fire, power failure, and game delays. These announcements are made to let fans make informed decisions concerning their well-being and provide specific instructions about what to do. If possible, please familiarize yourself with the nearest exit points of the stadium.

Field Access

Only authorized personnel with proper credentials will be permitted on the field before, during or after a game. Violators will be subject to prosecution. In addition, no one under the age of 15 will be allowed onto the field/sidelines during a game.



If you need first aid or medical assistance while at Johnny Unitas® Stadium, please contact any event staff employee for assistance. First aid stations are located on each concourse being used for the event. If assistance is needed with a health emergency, report the situation immediately to any of the stadium ushers, or uniformed police officers.

Food and Beverage

Food and drinks are prohibited from being brought into the stadium. Chartwells is the official concessionaire for Johnny Unitas® Stadium. Fans will find traditional stadium foods on the concourse(s) being used for the event.

Lost and Found

Found items should be turned into stadium security personnel. If an item is not recovered on game day, please check the university's Lost & Found location on the next business day in the University Union by calling 410-704-4636.

Solicitation/Literature

Resale of tickets, setting up a promotional space and/or distributing banners, booklets, business cards, circulars, commercial advertising, flyers, folders, handbills, leaflets, notices, pamphlets, petitions, posters, stickers, or any other written, printed and/or painted materials in or around Johnny Unitas® Stadium or SECU Arena without the permission of the Towson University Department of Event and Conference Services is prohibited.

Standing on Seats/Bleachers

Anyone found standing on a seat or bleacher will be ejected without warning. The university has suffered property damage in the past. Root hard, conduct good sportsmanship, and keep your feet on the ground.

Strollers

Strollers are permitted inside Johnny Unitas® Stadium, however, must be stored in designated areas.

Thrown Items

Cans, bottles, beach balls or any items that may be deemed as a projectile are not permitted into Johnny Unitas® Stadium. Violators will be subject to prosecution.

Umbrellas

Umbrellas are permitted into Johnny Unitas® Stadium, however, may not be opened to ensure the enjoyment of other fans. Rain ponchos are suggested for inclement weather.



Severe Weather Plan:

The MMBA State Championship will proceed rain or shine, pending extreme or dangerous conditions.

If dangerous weather is forecasted in the area, MMBA will make necessary adjustments and delays to the schedule.

In the event of non-dangerous rain or wind, it will be up to the band's discretion on how they proceed with their performance.
