Fundraising/Budget

The band program budget presented at the final Band Booster meeting of SY 2013-2014 included expenditures totaling \$47,120.

Over \$6,000 was paid by the Band Boosters in support of the band program, excluding the marching band. They paid for clinicians, awards, UMD Clarinet Day participants, and over \$4,000 of instrument repairs and supplies.

Unlike other schools in the state, we do not <u>require</u> fundraising from each student. However, for us to break even this year we need each student to raise \$33.


